Rabies eradicated in France: No cases of animal rabies have been reported in France since October 1996, when a fox shot in the Ardennes region near Belgium was found to be infected. The success seems to be due to a vaccination campaign, with helicopters dropping meat containing the vaccine around the countryside.
